MOUNT CARBINE PLANT CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

- A Project Manager has been appointed for the Mt Carbine operations. He joins the Carbine Tungsten team with a wealth of experience that is relevant to construction, commissioning and continuous running of mining operations.
- The modular relocatable Kelsey Jig plant, including derrick screens, pumps and valves, has been refurbished and construction is complete.
- The Motor Control Centre (MCC) is now on site and is being installed, and will be complete before 23 December 2011.
- The concrete pads have been poured and are ready to receive the concentrate processing shaking tables that are due on site early in January 2012.
- The front end to the tailings retreatment plant is mobile and built on skids, and will arrive on site in January 2012, which will allow commissioning to commence.
- Discussions with “off takers” are proceeding extremely well. Detailed discussions continue and will be finalised in the first quarter of 2012.
